CLERK: (Read LB 835 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: There has been a request for a roll call in reverse order. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 835 pass? The Clerk will call the roll aye or nay.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2390 of the Legislative Journal.) 28 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of the bill.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members of the Legislature having voted in the affirmative, LB 835 is declared passed. Proceed to LB 835A.

CLERK: (Read LB 835A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 835A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the A bill? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 2391 of the Legislative Journal.) 31 ayes, 16 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority of the members having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We proceed with the Final Reading of LB 956.

CLERK: (Read LB 956 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 956 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted on final passage of 956? Please record the vote. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.
