AN ACT relating to rules of the road; to amend section 39-631, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change provisions prohibiting driving on shoulders of highways; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-631, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

39-631. No person shall drive on the shoulders of highways, except that (1) this section shall not prohibit the driving of vehicles may be driven onto the shoulders of roadways (a) by federal mail carriers while delivering the United States mail or (b) to safely remove a vehicle from traffic lanes or and (2) implements of husbandry from being may be driven thereon onto the shoulders of roadways.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-631, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
