

PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not turned on immediately.)
...Legislative Chamber. We are honored to have with us this morning, Dr. C. Rex Bevins, the minister at the St. Paul United Methodist Church in Lincoln. Dr. Bevins, please.

DR. BEVINS: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Dr. Bevins, we appreciate your coming this morning. Please come back and see us again. Roll call, please. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Are there any corrections to the Journal this morning?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do you have any messages at the moment?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do, Mr. President.
