SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The Chair recognizes Senator Conway, please.

SENATOR CONWAY: Mr. Speaker, I would like to respectfully withdraw the amendment to the amendment at this point. There is a minor correction that I had talked about earlier, but in my haste when I drafted this out, I did not make a provision for the Appropriations Committee's unique situation and I'd like to withdraw it. I will reintroduce it as a rule change when I've had an opportunity to do it in a little less hasty fashion and make that proviso like I had talked about earlier last year. So I'll do that and reintroduce it so I will withdraw it at this time.
