Since this section was passed in 1980, the transfer should be complete. I urge the advancement of LB 9 to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion is to advance LB 9, a repealer relating to the Division of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse that is obsolete. Discussion? If not, all in favor please vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 9.
