LB 204, Mr. President.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: The motion is passed. LB 204 is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, do you have further bills to read in?

Senator Pappas would ask unanimous consent to add his name to 344; and Senator Weihing to 344. (See pages 279-80 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: No objections, so ordered. Are there any others?


ASSISTANT CLERK: That is all I have, Mr. President.
