

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion to advance LB 129 made by Senator Moore. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried. The bill is advanced. General File, A bills, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 40A was a bill introduced by Senator Goodrich. (Read Title.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Goodrich, please. Senator Goodrich on LB 40A. Senator Goodrich is still yet to arrive, as is Senator Johnson. Let's proceed to LB 304A.

CLERK: LB 304A by Senator Hefner. (Read title.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hefner, please.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, I move for the advancement of 304A. This is an appropriation bill that accompanies LB 304. This is the mail-order bill. These mail-order companies would be mandated to collect sales tax on orders that they ship into our state. The first year it appropriates \$8,000 from the General Fund, and the second year \$5,000 from the General Fund. I move the advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: You have heard the motion by Senator Hefner to advance LB 304A. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, I rise to object to the advancement of LB 304A. I have an amendment on the original bill, LB 304, to strike the enacting clause. I intend to debate that when it comes again. I believe that it is time that we call attention to the fact that bills are moving across this board without debate, without attention, with very few people in the audience. I don't know where everybody is at but we just advanced some bills on Select File this morning, and when the people realize what is in some of those bills advanced by voice vote, when they know what is in those bills, Senator Scott's hair is going to be as short as mine, and I think it is time you take a look at these things. I object strenuously to the advancement of this bill and I wish the rest of you would take a look at it and at least read what is going on. If you can't read it, at least be here so that you can vote. I would ask the bill not be advanced.
