PRESIDENT: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is...all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 610 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Senator Landis, did you turn your light on for a purpose? Okay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 547 of the Legislative Journal.) 49 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of 610.

PRESIDENT: LB 610 passes with the emergency clause attached. I wish to draw your attention to the agenda for a moment. The first number on General File is 223, and 223 should be the first one on Select File on the back of your page under number 7. So LB 223 is on Select File and not on General File. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to put into the record? While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 31, LB 32, LB 33, LB 34, LB 35, LB 36, LB 37E, LB 66, LB 87, LB 110, LB 125, LB 127, LB 176, LB 69 with the emergency clause, LB 154, LB 171, LB 106, LB 109 with the emergency clause, LB 115, LB 137, LB 142 with the emergency clause, LB 291, and LB 610 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Judiciary reports LB 243 as indefinitely postponed; 262 as indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Chizek.

Hearing notices from Natural Resources for February 18, 19 and 20, signed by Senator Schmit.

Hearing notices from Urban Affairs for February 17, signed by Senator Hartnett.

Enrollment and Review reports 112, 132, 233, 245, 255, 264, 302, 386 and 387, all correctly Engrossed, all signed by Senator Moore.

Mr. President, your Committee on Banking reports LB 78 to General File with committee amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Remmers as Chair. (See pages 549-51 of the Legislative Journal.)
