

CLERK: Mr. President, 374 introduced by Senator Harris. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time on January 20, referred to the Government Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: (Gavel.) Ladies and gentlemen, we will have to tone down a little bit if we are going to hear the speakers on the floor, so I would ask your indulgence, please. (Gavel.) Would you please hold it down so we can hear the speakers. Senator Harris, please.

SENATOR HARRIS: Mr. President, this is a very simple bill. It involves the sale of two lots in an undeveloped area that is on the inventory of the Department of Corrections. It is surplus property that they want to get off of their books. The present owners will likely end up being...not the present owners, the people who presently use the property will likely end up being the owners of the property. It will be disposed of at auction and the monies will go into the General Fund. It is a very simple bill. It is surplus property. The Department of Corrections appeared in the hearing and said that they would like to get this property off their books. If there are no further questions on it, I would urge that we go ahead and advance it. It is a very simple bill. It is not going to be controversial. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Landis, please. Oh, excuse me. Okay, any other further discussion on the bill? Senator Harris, did you wish to close? The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the advancement of LB 374. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 374.

PRESIDENT: LB 374 is advanced. LB 389, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, 389 was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 20, referred to the Health Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments at this time.
