And, Mr. President, I have new A bills: (Read LB 506A and 187A by title for the first time. See pages 551-55 of the Legislative Journal for all above references.) That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: In that case we'll move on to LB...to the Select File and you will recall that we passed over 223 a little bit ago and that will be our first bill on Select File. Senator Scott Moore, are you available? Okay, Mr. Clerk, on...excuse me, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Moore, I don't have E & R but I do have other amendments, Senator. Mr. President, the first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Pappas. Senator Pappas's amendment is on page 491 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Did you wish to not take that up? All right. It is withdrawn.
