PRESIDENT: Senator Moore, please.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. We are going to pass over LB 140, go to 225.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 225 I have E & R, Senator, to that bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Moore, please.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to LB 225 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted. Anything further?
