ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 278E on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 278E be passed? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 598 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 278E is passed. That concludes Final Reading for this morning. I thank the body for the excellent cooperation in remaining in your seats during Final Reading. Messages, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing at this time to read in.

SPEAKER BARRETT: If not, we will then proceed to item 6 on the agenda. For the edification of the Legislature, the Chair feels compelled to announce that, as you have perhaps seen in the media, or heard, we are expecting a very brief visit by the Reverend Jesse Jackson. The approximate time for his introduction to the Legislature is ten-fifteen. That, at least, is the plan at this point. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and I do sign engrossed LB 39, LB 41, LB 133, LB 149, LB 152, LB 161, LB 201, LB 275, LB 276, LB 277, LB 278. CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill on Select File is LB 392. Senator Moore, I have E & R amendments pending, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Scott Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 392 be adopted.

SPEAKER BARRETT: You have heard the motion by Senator Moore to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Motion carried, they are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Senator.
