Mr. President, I have a motion by Senator Higgins to place LB 98 on General File, notwithstanding the action of the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee. That will be laid over.

Mr. President, I have a report from the Department of Roads regarding the Roads Operation Cash Fund that's filed in my office pursuant to statute. That will be on file in the office, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 79 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. (See page 650 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 79 passes. LB 112, please.

CLERK: (Read LB 112 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 112 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read. See page 651 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
