

CLERK: Nothing at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Wesely, are you prepared then on General File to go to 229A?

CLERK: Mr. President, 229A was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

SENATOR WESELY: I move for its advancement.
