523, approximately \$35,000 needs to be appropriated from the General Fund, \$15,000 from the Miscellaneous Services Revolving Fund, for fiscal year, July 1, '87 to June 30, '88, and \$5,000 from the General Fund and 25,000 from the Miscellaneous Services Fund for fiscal year, July 1, '88 to June 30, '89. These are very small dollar appropriations essentially designed to help the Department of Revenue as it changes forms and things of that nature. So, with that, I would move LB 523A.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: Questions or comments on LB 523A? Senator Johnson, does that include your closing?

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: That is my closing, Senator Johnson.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: The question is then, shall LB 523A be advanced to E & R? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
