CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 724 of the Legislative Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 216 is passed. Next bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. Senator Ashford would move to return LB 225 to Select File for a specific amendment. (Read Ashford amendment as found on page 724 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Ashford, please.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Yes, a technical amendment to change the word "notice" to "motion". Upon the motion of either party the summary jury trial can be ordered and not the notice of the party is the motion, so that is all we're doing by this change. Thank you.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion on Senator Ashford's motion? If not, the question is, shall the bill be returned to Select File for the purpose of an amendment? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The bill is returned. Senator Ashford, on the amendment.

SENATOR ASHFORD: Again, Mr. Speaker, this, I think I basically stated the reason for it and it is just a very technical amendment. It was intended to say motion and it said notice by mistake, and that's the purpose of this amendment. Thank you. I'd move the advancement of the bill, amendment, yes.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion on the motion to adopt the amendment as offered by Senator Ashford? There are no lights on, therefore, the question is, shall the amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.
