Business and Labor reports 344 to General File with amendment, 474 to General File. Agriculture reports 68 to General File, 325 indefinitely postponed. I have a new A bill, Mr. President. (Read LB 459A by title for the first time. See pages 820-21 of the Legislative Journal.)

And, Mr. President, the Education Committee reports 281 indefinitely postponed, 310 indefinitely postponed, 434 indefinitely postponed, 482 indefinitely postponed, 616 indefinitely postponed, and 765 indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Withem as Chair. That is all that I have. (See page 821 of the Journal.)
