

SPEAKER BARRETT:      The bill fails to pass with the emergency clause. I would ask the body then to again vote on the passage of LB 379 without the emergency clause. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have those voted who care to vote? Please record.

CLERK:      (Record vote read. See pages 847-48 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 8 nays, 1 present and not voting, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT:      LB 379 passes without the emergency clause. I would like to proceed to one additional motion then before the call is raised. This concludes Final Reading. A motion offered by Senator Vard Johnson, item 6 on the agenda. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK:      Mr. President, Senator Vard Johnson would move to withdraw LB 728. The motion is found on page 811 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BARRETT:      Senator Hartnett, will you be handling the motion?

SENATOR HARTNETT:      On behalf of Senator...Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, on behalf of Vard Johnson, he simply asked me to have this bill withdrawn at this time. He is simply...we are too busy...or he is too busy on other matters to take it up this year. So I don't think it does...I don't know what it does, really, but he would like to withdraw it. So, if the body would approve, I would simply withdraw it on behalf of Vard. Here's the bill, Ernie, if you want to look at it.

SPEAKER BARRETT:      Discussion. Discussion on the motion, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:      Mr. Chairman, may...instead of using my time to speak, can I use just a few second. to see what the bill is?

SPEAKER BARRETT:      Certainly. Any other questions or discussion on the motion? If not, then we will proceed to the voting. Those in favor of the motion to withdraw the bill vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK:      35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the motion to withdraw LB 728.

SPEAKER BARRETT:      The bill is withdrawn. The call is raised.
