

SPEAKER BARRETT PRESIDING

SPEAKER BARRETT: We welcome you to the thirty-sixth business day in the First Session of the Ninetieth Legislature. For our opening prayer this morning, I am pleased to present Pastor Rodney Hinrichs of the Rejoice in the Lord Church which is the old air base chapel at the old Lincoln Air Base. Pastor Hinrichs.
