year with a similar resolution. I ask for your support of LR 46.

PRESIDENT: With that threat, you may not get too many votes. The question is the adoption of the resolution. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 46.

PRESIDENT: The resolution is adopted. We'll jump to General File and to LB 292A.

CLERK: Mr. President, 292A was a bill that was introduced by Senator Hall. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on March 5, Mr. President. It was reported to General File which is customary with our A bills. LB 292 was advanced. We are now ready to discuss the A bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, Mr. President and members, 292A is a bill that deals with the workers' comp bill that we just passed over from General to Select and from Select to E & R the other day. It is an appropriation that is necessary to cover the state employees who would fall under this provision. So it is an amount of about \$10,000 this year. It would be about 20,000 for the second year of the biennium budget. I would urge the body to adopt...move the bill over to E & R Initial. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 292A.

PRESIDENT: The bill advances. We'll move on to LB 123. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, just one item and that is a confirmation report from the Transportation Committee. That is signed by Senator Lamb as Chair.

Mr. President, LB 123 was a bill that was originally introduced by Senator Pirsch and Senator Ashford. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 8, referred to Judiciary, advanced to
