

says, under state agency increased expenditures, political subdivision increased expenditures, and then as I read before, it says there would be some increased expenditures and I thought perhaps it would be prudent just to have somewhat of an estimate in that regard. And I guess I'm surprised that a very conservative senator such as yourself does not know how much this bill is going to cost.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Well, Senator, I have here a section by section dissertation of this bill and nowhere and if you want me to, and I'll run out of time, I'll start to read it.

SENATOR LAMB: I don't want to run you out of time. I just thought perhaps you had some information.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Before it comes up again I will have a fiscal note for you and if I feel that the fiscal note is too much, I will contact you and we will take care of it at that time.

SENATOR LAMB: Thank you very much.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any other discussion on the bill? Any closing, Senator Haberman? Those in favor of the advancement of LB 549 to E & R Initial please vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the advancement of 549. Have you all voted? Voting on the advancement of the bill. Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 549.

SPEAKER BARRETT: 549 is advanced. Next bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, General Affairs Committee I think just concluded their Executive Session. Did they? Okay. Mr. President, Agriculture Committee...I'm sorry. LB 450 was introduced by Senator Scofield and Senator Dierks. (Title read.) The bill was introduced on January 21, referred to the Agriculture Committee for hearing, advanced to General File. I have committee amendments pending by the Agriculture Committee, Mr. President.
