

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Rod Johnson, do you care to close on the committee amendments?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I'd just simply move for the amendments to be adopted.

SENATOR LAMB: The motion is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 102. Those in favor vote aye, those in opposition vote no. Have you all voted on the committee amendment? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SENATOR LAMB: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Rogers, on the bill.

SENATOR ROGERS: I just move to advance the bill, Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR LAMB: There are no other lights on, so the motion is the advancement of LB 102. Those in support vote aye, those opposed vote no. The motion is to advance LB 102 to E & R Initial. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 102.

SENATOR LAMB: LB 102 has been advanced. Next bill is LB 102A. Senator Rogers.

CLERK: Mr. President, 102A by Senator Rogers appropriates funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of 102. It was introduced on March 10, referred directly to General File.

SENATOR LAMB: Senator Rogers.

SENATOR ROGERS: I think we fairly well discussed what the fund is. It's simply so that they have the opportunity to expend money if they do receive money. It involves no state money. I move the advancement.
