

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you and I will clarify that with you, Senator Haberman, if you would like to. I just ask that the bill be advanced at this point.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The next speaker, Senator Hall, followed by Senator Moore. Approximately two and a half minutes remaining.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I will be very brief. Senator Haberman, to help clarify your question, the only time it would apply is if there is a third party that is involved other than owners of the business, an individual farmer. So if it's a direct agreement between the worker and anyone who has an interest in the business, this bill would not apply. The A bill that...or the fiscal note that you talked about has been remedied somewhat because of the committee amendments that increase the fee cost from \$100 to \$750. There has been an A bill introduced and I think that is what Senator Moore would like to question someone on right now. So I would yield the balance of my time to him and ask him to move very quickly.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Yes, I don't know if I need to direct my questions toward Senator Hall or Senator Smith, but it is my understanding that, with the changes in raising the fee from 100 to \$750, you have removed all General Fund impact to the bill and the A bill will strictly be a Cash Fund. Is that what I am led to understand?

SENATOR SMITH: That's the anticipation.

SENATOR MOORE: And there will be no General Fund impact with this bill. With the A bill there will be strictly a Cash Fund A bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: One minute on the bill.

SENATOR SMITH: LB 344A has already been introduced.

SENATOR MOORE: LB 344A has been...
