LB 368, 591

ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Hefner on the bill as amended.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President and members of the body, the bill now, as amendment has been adopted, the word "primarily" is stricken. The section clearly states that the exemption is granted when agriculture and soil conservation work is greater than 50 percent of the gross revenue earned. Also any exemption which is granted shall equal half of the amount of the tax otherwise due on the property, even if a percentage of work is more than 50 percent. The exemption shall be figured on each separate earth moving machine. This bill, in committee, had no opposition, and everybody is in agreement to it. So I move the advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion, please? If not, all in favor of the advancement of 591, as amended, please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the advancement of the bill? Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 591 is advanced. LB 368, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 368 was introduced by Senator Higgins. (Read title.) The bill was read for the first time the 20th of January, it was referred to the Urban Affairs Committee. They report the bill back to General File with committee amendments.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hartnett on the committee amendments.

SENATOR HARTNETT: The only, Mr. Speaker and members of the body, the only committee amendments is an emergency clause. So I move that we adopt the amendment.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Discussion? If not, all in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the E clause, committee amendments. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record.
