LB 347, 432, 473A, 473, 626, 650

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 473A on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 473A pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1180-81 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 473A passes with the emergency clause attached. Do you have anything to put in, Mr. Clerk, at this time?

CLERK: Just one item, Mr. President, and that is a new A bill, 656A by Senators Elmer, Dierks, and Peterson. (Read for the first time by title. See page 1181 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Okay, thank you. We will move on to consent calendar, but may I say that while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 432, LB 626, LB 347, LB 473, and LB 473A. We will move on to the consent calendar, and as you know, if the debate extends beyond 15 minutes and the introducer is not closing at the end of 15 minutes, the bill will be removed from consent calendar. So you may act accordingly when we are handling these bills. May I introduce guests of Senator Coordsen, please. In the north balcony coming in at this time are 18 students from Friend High School with their teacher. Welcome to the Legislature. Would you please welcome these students and teacher from Friend, Nebraska. Thank you for visiting us today. The Speaker has told me that we are passing over LB 395 and beginning with LB 650. Mr. Clerk. Incidentally, we will notify you when five minutes or when we have expired ten minutes that we are going on to the last five minutes so that you can act accordingly. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 650 was introduced by Senator Haberman. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 23, advanced to Banking Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
