PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphones not activated immediately.)  
...Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning for our morning prayer Reverend Gil Kisling of the Living Word Christian Outreach in Lincoln, Nebraska. Reverend Kisling, please.

REVEREND KISLING: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT: Thank you, Reverend Kisling. Please come back and see us again. Roll call, please.

CLERK: There is a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Do you have any corrections this morning?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: How about messages or reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports 376 to Select File, 376A, 576, and 577 all of those reported to Select File, signed by Senator Moore as the E & R Chair. (See pages 1267-68 of the Journal.)

Mr. President, I have an Attorney General's Opinion addressed to Senator Chambers. And the last item, Mr. President, is LR 59, 60, 61, 62 and 64 are ready for your signature.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 59, LR 60, LR 61, LR 62, and LR 64. We'll move on to legislative resolutions, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 63 offered by Senators Chizek, Chambers, Ashford, Korshoj, Marsh, Elmer and Beyer is found on page 1175. It congratulates the Nebraska State Patrol on its first 50 years of service and expresses the Legislature's best wishes for continued success in its law enforcement service to its citizens.

SENATOR CHIZEK: Mr. President, members, LR 63 is a simple resolution recognizing the 50th anniversary of the Nebraska
