PRESIDENT: Were you finished?

SENATOR WITHEM: Yeah, I'm finished.

PRESIDENT: Okay. Senator Baack, please.

SENATOR BAACK: Mr. President and members, I rise also to support the Lamb amendment. I am a supporter of LB 444 because I am a strong believer in one man, one vote. I talked about that yesterday on the veto override on the NRDs because I felt that that was an important aspect of that bill and I think this is an important amendment to this bill and I think we need to make it consistent across the board and, if we're going to have one man, one vote out in the rural districts, we need to have one man, one vote in the Omaha area, the metropolitan area also. So I am rising in support of this amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Hefner, then Senator Warner.

SENATOR HEFNER: Mr. President, I move we recess till one-thirty.

PRESIDENT: Before I entertain that motion, Mr. Clerk, do you have anything to put in?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. Your Committee on Business and Labor reports 519 to General File with amendments, 516 indefinitely postponed, 696 indefinitely postponed, 711 indefinitely postponed, and Senator Landis would move to place LB 88 on General File pursuant to Rule 3, Section 19(b). That will be laid over. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: I understand from the Speaker that we'll pick up right where we left off and the names that are on the board will be called in order that they are on that board at the present time. You've heard the motion to adjourn until one-thirty. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. Let's run that through again. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. We are adjourned until one-thirty.
