It simply sets up a different procedure for the local citizens within the counties to make their decisions on how they want their school district reorganized. I urge you to advance the bill.

PRESIDENT: The bill advances. Mr. Clerk, do you have something to put into the record?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Senator Marsh has amendments to be printed to 526. Health and Human Services Committee reports LB 557 to General File with amendments attached, signed by Senator Wesely. (See pages 1293-94 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, I have a notice of priority bill designation by the individual members, by committees, and by the Speaker to be inserted in the Journal. That is all that I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We will do Select File, then the Speaker says we will knock it off. Number 8, Select File, 581.

CLERK: Mr. President, 581, Senator, I have E & R amendments pending.

PRESIDENT: Senator Moore, please.

SENATOR MOORE: I move the E & R amendments to LB 581 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Senator.
