CLERK: LB 509, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I move that LB 509 be advanced.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Let's take LB 42, since we have a couple of minutes here. Mr. Clerk, do you have a motion on it?

CLERK: Mr. President, on 42, the first item are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Moore, please, E & R.

SENATOR MOORE: I move the E & R amendments to LB 42 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Smith would move to amend the bill. (See Smith amendment on page 1295 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT: Senator Smith, please.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. The amendment that I have up there would do two simple things. Number one, it is a correction in a reference to reporting provisions of the Department on Aging. It just simply adds in some words which makes it very clear that the reporting requirement will be simply the Care Management Report. The other thing is that it would include something that was inadvertently left out of this bill which was in our last bill was the fact that they could have a cash fund to receive grant money and other kinds of donations, and we have added that by this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? If not, the question is the adoption of the Smith amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the adoption of the Smith amendment. Need a little help here, please, if you care to vote. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Smith's amendment to the bill.
