PRESIDENT NICHOL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT: (Microphone not turned on immediately.)
...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. We have with us this morning Reverend Gil Karges of the Waverly United Methodist Church in Waverly, Nebraska. Would you please rise for the invocation.

PRESIDENT: Senator Korshoj, please.
