LB 42A, 679, 721, 774

SENATOR MOORE: I move LB 679 be advanced.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The question is, shall LB 679 be advanced? All in favor say aye. Opposed no. The ayes have it. Carried. The bill is advanced. LB 721.

CLERK: Mr. President, 721, I have no amendments to the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I move LB 721 be advanced.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall 721 be advanced? All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried. The bill is advanced. The last bill on Select File, LB 774.

CLERK: LB 774, Senator, I have no amendments to the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I move LB 774 be advanced.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Shall 774 be advanced? All in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried. The bill is advanced. As previously announced, the Chair would like to go to General File for one bill, LB 42A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 42A is a bill introduced by Senator Smith. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on March 24 and referred directly to General File, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Jacklyn Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you. I would just like to say at this time that the A bill, that you...you probably have a copy of it there, does not accurately reflect what will be the anticipated cost. We feel that it's too high. There are some things like the Cash Fund that we added in, as an amendment the other day, to the bill, there has been a willingness on the part of the area agencies to search for funds within their existing budgets, utilizing those funds for start-up costs. And so we are anticipating the ability to cut down further the costs that we do see in the A bill and I would just ask your indulgence in advancing the A bill at this time and then holding it on Select File until we can have time to work it out at a new revised
