CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Your Committee on Revenue whose Chair is Senator Vard Johnson would report LB 457 to General File with amendments, and 632 General File with amendments. Those are signed by Senator Johnson, as Chair. (See pages 1385-89 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have notice of hearing from the Ag Committee, confirmation hearing, Mr. President. A new resolution by Senators Beyer and Withem. (Read explanation of LR 70. See pages 1289-90 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over.

Mr. President, Senator Beyer would move to reconsider the vote on Final Reading of LB 307. That will be laid over. And that is all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Proceed then to Item 6 on the agenda, motions, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nelson would move to place LB 72 on General File pursuant to Rule 3, Section 19 (b). Senator Nelson filed her motion on March 24. It is on Journal page 1224, Mr. President. Subsequent to that action, LB 72 was reported as indefinitely postponed by the Health and Human Services Committee.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Senator Nelson, please, on the motion.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, my motion to raise from committee is my bill, LB 72, which in essence would ban free giveaway of smokeless tobacco at all public events, such as county fairs, state fairs, Husker Harvest Days, agricultural events, rodeos and so on. First of all, I want to
