to occur in 1990 because, realistically, looking at the rates around, you just know that 4 percent on 5 million, which is a higher level than we currently have, is going to stand come 1990. The small tracks will not do it, and the position you are going to be in is you will have all five tracks in here in 1990 trying to get those rates down. At least let the little tracks survive, help the quarter horse tracks, well, they are exempt now anyway as a practical matter at the current level, but the other three tracks or four tracks are not all that different. I think it is a reasonable, inevitable solution that ought to be adopted now.
