

SENATOR WEIHING: Mr. Speaker, I ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER BARRETT: You've heard the request for a call of the house. Those members in favor of putting themselves under call please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 4 nays to go under call, Mr. President.
