CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1613-14 of the Legislative Journal.) 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 526 passes. LB 587E.

CLERK: (Read LB 587 on Final Reading.)

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1614-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 587E passes. Last bill, 679E.

CLERK: (Read LB 679 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 679 with the emergency clause attached become law? Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1615-16 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 2 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: LB 679E passes. The call is raised. Anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?
