SPEAKER BARRETT: Time has expired. On the Chambers motion to recommit the bill to the Revenue Committee, any discussion? Senator Abboud, your light is on. Senator Abboud, do you care to discuss the motion? Pass. Senator Moore, your light is on. Do you care to discuss it.

SENATOR MOORE: I move we adjourn until 9:00 a.m., April 24.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Anything for the record?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Senator Hall has amendments to be printed (LB 775). Senator Vard Johnson amendments (LB 523). New A bill, Mr. President, 775A appropriates funds for LB 775. And I have other amendments, Mr. President, to LB 80 to be printed. That is all that I have. (See pages 1825-28 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. You have heard the motion to adjourn until nine o'clock tomorrow morning. A machine vote has been requested. Those in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Record. Record vote has been requested.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1828 of the Journal.) 2 ayes, 27 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adjourn.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion fails. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, we are still on Senator Chambers' motion to refer.

SPEAKER BARRETT: We have several lights on. Let me go down the list. Senator Schmit, would you care to speak to it? Senators Hefner and Vard Johnson to follow.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members, I appreciate very much the opportunity to speak this evening because I would hope that you would then do, as has been indicated earlier by Senator Chambers, review the bill again tonight some more. There has been a lot of work done on the bill, I do not deny that. Revenue Committee has worked on it as long as I think any committee could be expected to work on a bill. I've been told that it was primarily the work of the Governor's office. Very frankly, I preferred the Governor's amendment on the personal property taxes rather than the committee's.
