SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The question is the indefinite postponement of LB 288. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. The bill is on General File, a simple majority will prevail. Have you all voted? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I'd ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Call of the house has been requested. Those in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, opposed nay. Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 2 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The house is under call. Members, please check in. Those outside the Chamber, please return to the Chamber. We are under call. Senator Lynch, would you please check in. Senator Ashford, the house is under call. Senator Schmit, would you check in, please. Senator Conway. Senator Rupp and Senator Ashford. We've had a request for a reverse roll call vote. Senator Ashford, the house is under call. All present and accounted for. Mr. Clerk, proceed. Reverse order.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 2074 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion prevails. The bill is killed and the call is raised. Anything for the record? Anything for the record?
