SENATOR PAPPAS: Mr. Speaker, colleagues, 183A is a very good piece of legislation drafted by Senator Warner. In his absence I must say that if you take time to really read it through, you find out what a meritorious piece of legislation it is and I ask for its advancement.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion? Any discussion? If not, those in favor of advancing the bill to E & R Initial vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the advancement of the bill. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
