SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I believe Senator Remmers explained the committee amendments which have now become the bill. Unless there are questions for either one of us, I would merely urge that you advance the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Any discussion on the advancement of the bill? Seeing none, those in favor of the advancement, please vote aye, opposed nay. On the advancement of 416. Record, Mr. Clerk.
