SENATOR MOORE: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, as you can see if you look at the committee statement, LB 237 is a noncontroversial bill endorsed by both those entities of submutual funds as well as the Nebraska Bankers Association and the independent bankers. The bill, quite simply, would allow and give state chartered banks the same privilege as nationally chartered banks in regard to the purchase of mutual funds. And, with that, I would simply move for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. Discussion? Any discussion on the advancement of the bill? If not, those in favor of advancing LB 237 to E & R Initial please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of 237, Mr. President.
