CLERK: I have nothing further on that bill, Senator.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I move we advance LB 783A.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Any discussion on the advancement of the bill? If not, those in favor of the advancement of 783A please signify by saying aye. Opposed no. The ayes have it, the motion carries, the bill is advanced. LB 784. Certainly, anything for the record first?

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, I do, thank you. A study resolution by Senator Rod Johnson, LR 153. (Read introductions of LRs 153-159 as found on pages 2167-71 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the next bill for consideration is LB 784. The first item I have on that, Senator, are E & R amendments.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: Mr. President, I move we adopt the E & R amendments to LB 784.

SPEAKER BARRETT: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. Those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Carried, they are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Hall. Senator Hall's amendment is on page 2001 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Senator Hall, please.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. President and members. As the Clerk stated, this amendment is on 2001 of the Journal and it is an amendment that was attempted on General File by myself and it would allow for the purchase or the expenditure of approximately \$345,000 in the two years of the budget period to the Legislative Council for Program 122 to provide for the purchase of computer equipment and software for use in each of the senators' office. At that time on General File we got 20 votes for this proposal. There were about six people who were absent
