SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Madam President and members, after what we've been through so far this afternoon and the fact that the effort by Senator Landis at this point in time was unsuccessful, this amendment would deal with treating the professors at technical colleges the same as those professors at state colleges and universities is probably inappropriate and we can do it at a better time and I respectfully withdraw the amendment at this time.

SENATOR LABEDZ: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, do you have any further amendments?

CLERK: Madam President, I have a motion. I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Senator Warner, there are no further amendments. Senator Moore, are you here to advance the bill? Senator Warner.
