ASSISTANT CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate,  
Mr. President.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Debate is ceased. Senator Warner, would you  
care to close on your motion?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the  
motion to take up LB 130 is because there are two forms of  
increased revenue that would be germane to this bill as it is  
written. There would either be the sales tax or the income tax.  
There is a motion pending for sales tax. Seems appropriate that  
we deal with the revenue side as closely as we can to the  
appropriation side and I misspoke a moment ago when I said  
12 million, there is, at a minimum reserve, based on what we  
have advanced and only in the appropriation bills, not counting  
A bills or any of the exemptions, there is 10 million to cover  
almost \$19 million of legislation beyond General File and there  
is roughly another 10.5 million to cover 24 million of bills  
beyond General File for '88-89. Obviously to go with that  
minimum reserve, probably is not prudent and in order to  
accomplish many things I think the body needs to address the tax  
issue. If the body is unwilling to do a tax issue, obviously we  
have to do something different with the budget. I would move  
the adoption of the motion to take up LB 130.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. You've heard the closing and the  
question is, shall the Speaker's order be changed? Those in  
favor vote aye, opposed nay. Thirty votes necessary. Have you  
all voted if you care to vote? Have you all voted? Record,  
Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to change  
the agenda.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Motion prevails. The call is raised.  
Mr. Clerk, proceed to LB 130.

CLERK: If I might right before that, Mr. President, two items  
for the record. New resolutions, 176 calls for a study of  
prison industries; 177 calls for a creation of a Select  
Committee on Adoption. Both those will be referred to  
Reference. (See pages 2219-20 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, LB 130 is on Select File. The first order of  
business are Enrollment and Review amendments.
