LR 127-129, 132

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 127, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LR 127 is adopted. LR 128.

CLERK: Mr. President, 128 by Senator Schellpeper, found on page 2094, recognizes the residents of the village of Howells.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schellpeper, please.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. President. Howells is also located in Colfax County. It is a town of about 1,200 people and their centennial dates are July 3, 4 and 5. I move for the adoption.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the explanation. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. (Gavel.) Could I have your attention, please. I'd like a little bit of cooperation in passing these resolutions, please. Thank you. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the resolution.

PRESIDENT: LR 128 is adopted. LR 129, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, 129 by Senator Schellpeper, on 2095 of the Journal, recognizes the residents of Rogers.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schellpeper, please.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Thank you, Mr. President. Rogers is also in Colfax County. I don't think it was named after Carson Rogers because he probably isn't old enough for that, but it is probably some of his relation. It has a population of a little over 100 people and their centennial is June 14th. I move for the adoption.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the explanation. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of 129, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LR 129 is adopted. LR 132, please.

CLERK: 132, Mr. President, by Senator Wehrbein found on page 2111 recognizes and applauds the efforts of the Syracuse Volunteer Fire Department on their 100th anniversary.
