Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Senator Lynch, please. Senator Chizek, please. Senator Lowell Johnson, please. Senator Higgins, record your presence. Senator Pirsch, please check in. Senator Scofield. Senator Warner, please check in. Senator Wehrbein. Senator Lynch, please check in. Senator Pirsch, please check in. Members, return to your seats. (Gavel.) Roll call in reverse order has been requested. Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 2230 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER BARRETT: The motion prevails. LB 375 is advanced to E & R Initial. The call is raised. Anything for the record?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Mr. President, I have a confirmation report from the Natural Resources Committee to be inserted.
