SENATOR WITHEM: Other than to say that Rod Johnson is no fun at all, it is always fun to have some vehicles out there to do some good things at the end of the session, I think probably this is not one of those. I think probably the cleanest, simplest, easiest thing to do would be to support Senator Higgins' motion and would suggest that you do. I am not going to urge you to, I guess, but suggest that you do that.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Abboud, please

SENATOR ABOUD: Question.

PRESIDENT: That won't be necessary because you are the last light. Senator Higgins, did you wish to close on your motion? The question is the adoption of the motion of Senator Higgins to indefinitely postpone. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone the bill.

PRESIDENT: LB 529A is indefinitely postponed. Move on to LB 688, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, 688 is on Select File. The Enrollment and Review amendments were adopted on May 6. There was an amendment from Senators Withem and Miller to the bill that was adopted on May 6. I have pending, Mr. President, an amendment from Senator Lamb. Senator Lamb's amendment is on page 2004 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lamb, please.

SENATOR LAMB: I will withdraw that amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: It is withdrawn. Do you have anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, I have an amendment from Senator Baack to the bill. Senator Baack is excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Senator Miller, are you authorized to handle that motion.

SENATOR MILLER: Yes, I am.
