They're talking about they publish this because of their convictions. Whatever Harper wants Harper is going to get. Senator Schmit said that I've come to the realization that there is a certain amount of wear and tear that the Legislature will tolerate and beyond that you can't push them. That might be true, but I don't know where that point is, Senator Schmit. So I must press on with my effort and this amendment was in line with what I think ought to be done with this bill. There are some people who have very serious concerns about this exemption that currently exists in the bill with reference to capital gains. I know there will be more votes in favor of this amendment than the ones that I had offered earlier, but the carryover, the reverberations from Mike Harper's thunderous declaration earlier may scare off some support that this amendment had. Mr. Speaker, how much time do I have left on this, one minute?

SPEAKER BARRETT: Approximately one minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There are a couple of other things I want to say about the way Mike Harper has dealt with people who he perceives as weak, not just in the Legislature, that I don't have the time to say on this amendment, because those who have discussed it have tried to stick to just what the amendment deals with. And, if they have said anything that might sway somebody to vote for it, I don't want to undo that good that they have done because it will be a positive good they have accomplished if they persuade some people to vote for this amendment. The reason my name is on it is because one of my motions had to be used for the purpose of substituting, not to allow somebody else to get out of place and bring a motion up from the nether regions into the celestial heights where I can currently be found, Senator Gary Hannibal. So I hope what you will do is vote in favor of this amendment.
