CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. I might offer one other item for the Journal and that is a confirmation report by the Natural Resources Committee, signed by Senator Schmit.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first resolution this morning is LR 225. It is found on page 2357. Senator Hannibal, I believe, is primary sponsor. (Read explanation.) Again, Mr. President, the resolution is on page 2357.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Senator Hannibal, please.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, LR 225 recognizes the Midwest Regional Grain Marketing Compact that has come into fruition because five states have approved the contract, and the compact calls for the appointment by the Governor of three individuals to represent the State of Nebraska, two of which would be from the Legislature, and one from the public at large. The resolution urges the Governor appoint two of our legislators, Senator Schmit and Senator Warner, as the compact's representatives for the region from the State of Nebraska based on their long-standing experience in the Legislature and their experience and expertise in agriculture and grain marketing. This is an urging to the Governor and I would urge the body to approve the resolution.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of LR 225. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of LR 225.

PRESIDENT: LR 225 is adopted. LR 226.

CLERK: Mr. President, 226 by Senator Elmer, found on page 2382. (Read explanation.)
