

SENATOR PIRSCH: Just very briefly. I appreciate your patience on this issue. I appreciate Senator Chambers allowing this to be voted up or down. I do have an amendment in hand that we had discussed about the custodial parent, and would be happy to talk with and introduce that on Final Reading. And I guess that all I have to say is that I would hope you would give consideration to the retail merchants and advance LB 536.

SPEAKER BARRETT: Thank you. The motion is to advance LB 536 to E & R Engrossing. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the advancement of the bill. Senator Ashford.

SENATOR ASHFORD: I ask for a call of the house with call in votes.
