Senator Johnson has closed, the question is the adoption of Senator Lowell Johnson's amendment to the Schmit's amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Please vote if you care to vote. This is Select File. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Johnson.

SENATOR L. JOHNSON: I would suggest a call of the house, Mr. President.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The question is whether the house should come under call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to go under call.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The house is under call. Please return to your seats and record your presence. All members not in the Chamber, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. All unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor. Please look up to see if your green light is on. The house is under call. Please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Senator Conway, please report to the Chamber, the house is under call. Senator Johanns, please. Senator Landis, please, the house is under call. Senator Johnson, did you call for a roll call vote? Senator Conway, please, the house is under call. Senator Goodrich, please. Senator Johnson, evidently Senator Conway and Senator Goodrich are not in the building. Would you care to go with a roll call vote? Roll call vote, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 2489-90 of the Legislative Journal.) 16 ayes, 15 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: The amendment fails. Do you have anything for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do. Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 298, 480, 736A, 767, 767A, all correctly Engrossed. That is signed by Senator Moore. And, Mr. President, amendments to 367A to be printed. (See pages 2491-92 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Thank you. Back to the amendment, on the Schmit amendment to 224, Senator Moore, your light is on.
